Current Projects:

- So far this year, councillors have organised anti-bullying week work, met with CAT safeguarding officers, created and agreed lunchtime rules, created and developed playground rules, obtained pupils voice each term on aspects of school life including community involvement, recycling, careers and healthy schools.

- School council members will continue to raise awareness of issues and concerns from children in their classes.
