Chadsmead Coverage of Music in EYFS

In EYFS, music includes the prerequisite skills for music within the national curriculum. Music lessons are taught with the use of Charanga Reception units: Me (Autumn 1); Songs for the Christmas performance (Autumn 2); My Stories (Spring 1); Everybody (Summer 1); Big Bear Funk (Summer 2).



We are also trialling new reception resources from Sing Up to supplement our music provision:

I've got a Grumpy Face; The Sorcerer's Apprentice; Witch, Witch; Row, Row, Row Your Boat.

Bird Spotting; Cuckoo Polka; Shake My Sillies Out; Up and Down; Five Fine Bumble Bees.

Down There Under the Sea; It's Oh So Quiet; Slap Clap Clap; Bow, Bow, Bow Belinda.
