## Chadsmead Primary Academy - Year 3 & 4 Home Learning

These are the expectations for the home learning.

Reading	Books are changed when a ZPD quiz has been completed: depending on the book length, this should be around once a week.  Reading books must be in school every day but <b>pupils should be reading for at least fifteen minutes a day at home.</b> Please keep an eye on your child's ZPD range and encourage their daily reading routine.  ZPD, phonics speed sounds and Y1-Y4 common exception words can be found in reading diary.
Spelling	New spellings are given out on a Friday and are tested the following Friday.  Please help your child to practise their spellings in preparation for the test each week.  Pupils have a green spelling practice book to use at school and home.  We use the 5 S's spelling method: see it, say it, spell it, scribe it, solve it.
English	Homework will be given out on a <b>Thursday and should be completed for the following Tuesday.</b> Any work should be kept in the pupil's purple homework book. English homework that matches the current learning is given every <b>fortnight.</b>
Maths	Homework will be given out on a <b>Thursday and should be completed for the following Tuesday.</b> Any work should be kept in the pupil's purple homework book.  Maths homework that matches the current learning is given every <b>fortnight.</b>
