Chadsmead Coverage of Music in EYFS

In Early Years, music is covered through carefully planned activities which develop children's confidence in order for them to explore sound and move rhythmically. Children are encouraged to take part in daily singing sessions, compose body percussion patterns, perform, explore instrumental sounds, take part in listening activities, explore different genres of music and see how they link with characters in stories.



30-50 Months: Communication and Language / Listening and Attention Joins in with repeated refrains

Enjoys rhyming and rhythmic activities

Recognises rhythm in spoken words

Sings a few familiar songs

Beginning to move rhythmically

Imitates movement in response to music

Taps out simple repeated rhythms

Explores and learns how sounds can be changed

Explores the different sounds of instruments

Children talk about the ideas and processes which have led them to make music, designs, images or products. They can talk about features of their own and others' work, recognising the differences between them and the strength of others.




Chadsmead Coverage of Music Y1/2 CYCLE 2






Chadsmead Coverage of Music Y3/4 CYCLE 1






Chadsmead Coverage of Music Y3/4 CYCLE 2






Chadsmead Coverage of Music Y5/6 CYCLE 1


