Buddhist Temple School Visit Friday 28th June 2024

In Years 3 and 4 the children are learning about Buddhism. As part of our learning we have arranged a trip to the Wat Mahathat, a Buddhist temple, in Kings Bromley. Whilst there, the children will listen to a brief talk centred around their learning and take part in some interactive activities.
