## Year 5/6 Visit to Black Country Living Museum: Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2024

Dear Parents and Carers

As part of the History curriculum for the Spring term, the children in Years 5 and 6 will be visiting the Black Country Living Museum on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2024.

The visit will be an opportunity for the children to experience hands on what life was like for children living in Victorian Britain including a Victorian school classroom experience.

We will <u>depart school at 8.45am</u>, children to arrive at school for 8.30am prompt and <u>return to school for approximately 4.00pm</u>.

To enable the trip to take place we will require a payment of £25.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entrance into the museum. **A deposit of £5.00 to secure your child's place payable by 1**<sup>st</sup> **December 2023.** Payments can be made in instalments. Please note refunds for absence on the day cannot be made.

All children are required to wear school uniform, please ensure children bring along a waterproof coat and wear sensible outdoor footwear. Please note children will spend a lot of the day outside and so may require extra clothing layers. All children will need a packed lunch. If your child receives Free School Meals they are entitled to a free packed lunch, please notify the school office as soon as possible if required.

Please make the payment in full via Parent Pay by Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2024, you will also be asked to tick a consent box as part of the payment process which authorises your son/daughter to attend the trip.

Children who have prescribed medicines (e.g. Asthma Inhalers, Epi-pens etc.) MUST bring these with them.
